Ghana/Togo Mission Report

Just a brief catch-up to let you know a bit of where we are and what we have been doing. First of all, we want to express our deepest gratitude for your (prayerfully) continued support. In 2023, we spent approximately \$1,000,000 in Ghana and Togo. As I type this, our brothers in Ghana are in the North of Ghana and Togo strengthening churches we planted in September and baptizing and planting

In 2023 we sponsored about 48 campaigns and treated more than 11,000 patients at the hospital in Dzodze. We also have about 1500 children enrolled in our schools. We planted 180 churches throughout Ghana and Togo and built 56 worship structures. We currently need to build about 120 more to catch up. We are predicting about 105 new church plants in 2024. We also supported 180 preachers in 2023 and anticipate adding about 168 more in 2024. We gave out 50 proclaimers, which is a solar powered device with New Testament on it in the local language. It is a beautiful thing to see their faces light up when they can hear the Word of God in their language. We also gave out approximately 200 Bibles, bought benches for churches, paid for some medicine, Dr. visits, and various other things. Those of us who go, pay our own way and do as much benevolent work as possible.

As you can see, we have been and continue to be very busy and active. We have been making three trips a year for a few years now. On our last trip in September 2023, we ventured far north in Ghana, farther than we had ever been. We were told by a local preacher we were wasting our time as there is such a heavy Muslim influence that we could not be successful. The Lord had other plans! We planted 44 churches and baptized mor than 2100! We have been negligent in sending out proper newsletters


