**DON'T LET ME FORGET**

Alzheimer's disease has often been called *"the long goodbye."* For families who walk this path, each day can bring new grief as familiar memories fade and pieces of a cherished life slowly slip away. Yet even in this heartbreaking journey, Scripture offers us steady comfort:

"I will not forget you. See, I have engraved you on the palms of My hands." — *Isaiah 49:15-16*

There is a hymn many of us love — *"Lead Me to Calvary"* — that gives voice to this same longing to remember.

Its refrain becomes a prayer we all need:

*Lest I forget Gethsemane,  
 Lest I forget Thine agony,  
 Lest I forget Thy love for me,  
 Lead me to Calvary.*

For those living with memory loss, or caring for someone who is, these are more than words. They are a lifeline. I once knew a dear Christian sister who battled Alzheimer's. After she passed, her daughters found a small purse in her room. Inside was a handwritten note she had written to herself:

**"God, don't let me forget You!"**

What a simple, powerful prayer.

And how gracious God is to answer it.

Jesus knew our tendency to forget, not only in illness but in every-day life. So on the night before the cross, He gave us a gift—the Lord's Supper—and said, **"Do this in remembrance of Me."** (Luke 22:19)

Paul repeats it in 1 Corinthians 11:24-25, reminding us that Communion is a memorial meant to draw our hearts back to the cross again and again.


